National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency (NGA), MOJAVE FA1

Data Science, Statistical Analysis, and Visualization: The EEO Office required data-driven decision support and analytics on various workforce segments. We applied advanced analytics techniques using SQL, Excel, and Tableau to analyze corporate human resource data and conduct inferential statistical analysis. We communicated results through executive-level dashboards, reports, and briefings to inform leadership decisions across multiple organizational levels.

Strategic Planning & Performance Management: The National GEOINT College (NGC) required a new strategy and way to measure organizational performance. We spearheaded the development and implementation of an enterprise strategic planning framework, including a strategic plan, execution tracker, performance reports, and resource allocation tools. The solution improved organizational accountability, performance visibility, and execution discipline across strategic initiatives.

Governance and Business Analysis: The NGA Advisory Board recommended developing a strategy for GEOINT Functional Management authorities. Using structured analysis methods including SWOT, we developed a multi-year strategic roadmap to improve governance effectiveness and operational alignment. The approach and plan were briefed to the NGA Advisory Board and NGA Director, resulting in approved execution planning and organizational adoption of recommended governance improvements.

Security Operations & Compliance: The NGA Security & Installation Directorate required mission-critical support across physical, personnel, and operational security functions. We ensured the uninterrupted operation and compliance of SCIFs, through access control, clearance verification, and SAP/CAP eligibility checks. We supported end-to-end personnel security lifecycle processes, including investigative support and adjudication documentation, improving compliance accuracy and operational continuity in secure environments.
